Free wallet cards are available to the public. These cards explain the Oklahoma breastfeeding law from 2004 and the National Law from 2010. In 2004, legislation was passed acknowledging that mothers have the right to breastfeed in public places and also exempting breastfeeding mothers from jury duty. In 2010, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act was passed that states employers shall provide reasonable break time and a private place for an employee to express breast milk for her nursing child for one year.

National Law 2010 - Patient Protection & Affordable Care Act · Employers shall provide reasonable break time and a private place for an employee to express breast milk for her nursing child for one year.

Oklahoma Law 2004 · Mothers have the right to breastfeed anywhere. They have a right to be excused from jury duty upon request.
